4. General Site/Feature Description: The site features a cluster of prospect adits and pits apparently driven during or before the 1880s. The adits collapsed, the waste rock dumps are overgrown, and a shop has been reduced to a platform. Between the late 1890s and 1910s, long after the adits were abandoned, someone built a log cabin, which still stands. During the 1960s or 1970s, the cabin was repaired and the surrounding area improved with a plank deck, walkway, propane tank, and stockpile of lumber. Someone also cached industrial materials moved from the adjacent Ouray Mine (Site 5ST268). The cabin is currently vacant and will be rehabilitated and stabilized by the town of Breckenridge. The cabin possesses architectural integrity and is recommended eligible for the SRHP. For a detailed site history, description, and interpretation, see the report noted below.

5. Historic Component Date(s) and/or Sociopolitical Period: Prospect Complex: prior to 1890; Cabin: 1890s-1910s  
Justification: Cut nails indicate that the prospect complex was active prior to 1890. Amethyst glass, wire nails, and architectural style and workmanship indicate that the cabin was built between the 1890s and 1910s.
